



Adult Leader Volunteers -

In anticipation of an upcoming change from our National Office in unit leaders being required to be trained, the Shenandoah Area Council is getting a jump start on this.

REQUIRED TRAINING goes into effect January 2011 for the top unit leaders (Cubmasters, Scoutmasters, Varsity Scout Coaches, Venturing Advisors, and Skippers), and in January 2012 for ALL positions with contact with the Scouts; all Assistant Scoutmasters, Den Leaders (and Assistant Den Leaders), Assistant Venturing Crew Advisers, Assistant Varsity Coaches and Ship Mates have to be fully trained in their positions.

BEFORE that time arrives, though, we need to get a fix on the current training status of individual leaders, including committee members. To help that along, the Council has a form we are asking all leaders to fill out (rather than have everyone copy training cards) and submit to the Training Crew.

The form can be found at attached and can be found at www.sac-bsa.org; click on the Training tab.

Please fill one out as completely as possible utilizing the data from your training cards for courses completed and dates of completion. If you don't know the exact date, but know you took a course, give us your BEST recollection (so don't just guess if you have the cards; please give me the actual date if you can).

When you have filled out the form, please return it to the Mannahoac District Training Crew at ellen.hall@hq.doe.gov and we will update/confirm what is in the SAC records and provide corrected/additional information to Council.

Not wanting to drag this process out any longer than necessary, but also wanting to give you sufficient time to conduct a "good" search for dates, please return the forms to ellen.hall@hq.doe.gov no later than June 30.
