

Stain Glass Eagle Scout Badge Light Box Reservations

(Please print all information clearly.)

Rules of use:

1. The Eagle Scout Badge Light Box (ESBLB) is available to Scouters in the Shenandoah Area Council on a first come first serve basis with two exceptions. An Eagle Scout Court of Honor has precedence over all other uses, except another Eagle Scout Court of Honor. NESA/Eagle Scout activities or events have precedence over all other uses, except an Eagle Scout Court of Honor.
2. Since use is first come, first serve, we strongly recommend that you make a reservation to use the ESBLB more than 30 days in advance of the planned event.
3. By signing below, the responsible person indicates their willingness to be responsible for any damages to the ESBLB during the period they have the ESBLB checked out from the Scout office.
4. The ESBLB is 44 inches high, 32 inches wide, and 16 inches deep. Since it is made with glass, make sure your vehicle can safely accommodate a box this size **without exposing** it to the elements. (Please no open pickup beds.)
5. Make sure you have a grounded extension cord available to allow safe and flexible placement of the ESBLB.
6. Cooperation with other units, as long as there are no time conflicts, is requested
7. PICK-UP and RETURN the ESBLB at the Shenandoah Area Council Scout Office.
8. Shawnee District and NESA handle maintenance and management of the ESBLB.
