

SAC Myth Buster: Myth – The Council has not put any money into Camp Rock Enon for routine maintenance and camp projects.

FACT: In 2011 the council spent (minus donations and summer camp operations) \$61,000 in maintenance, renovations, new equipment, special projects, and purchase of program items with an additional \$48,870 in normal routine operations of year round camp. That is a total of \$110,870 out of pocket by the Council (\$81,000 non-budgeted) spent this year on Camp Rock Enon outside of summer camp operations. On top of the above actual costs, we are thankful for more than \$24,000 in donated materials and labor on the projects completed this year.
