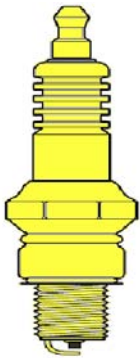
Shawnee District Recognition Awards

District Award of Merit: The District Award of Merit is a council award presented by districts. The award recognizes Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature at the district level. Additional community, civic, religious service outside of Scouting must also be evident. Separate Nomination form is required and can be found at www.sac-bsa.org/document/shawnee-district-award-of-merit/170702. Up to one per 25 units can be presented.

Bill Campbell Award: Presented to a Scouter (Cub, Scout BSA, Venture) whom you think of when you think of Scouting. A volunteer who does not often get the "Thank You", but simple works to make the unit, district, or Scouting in general better. A minimum of three (3) years of tenure in a position is required. Only one per year will be presented.

Rookie Leader of the Year in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, and Venturing/Exploring: This award is presented annually to a Unit Scouter in each program, (tenure of less than 18 months in their current program), who is doing an outstanding job; but whose tenure is insufficient to warrant other training awards. Evidence of Scout Spirit and service to youth must be noted in your submission. One per program will be presented each year in the District.

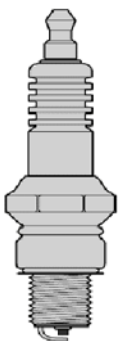
Leader of the Year in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, and Venturing/Exploring: This award is presented annually to a Unit Scouter in each program, (tenure of more than 18 months in their current program), as recognition for an outstanding job. Evidence of Scout Spirit and service to youth must be noted in your submission. One per program will be presented each year in the District.



Golden Spark Plug Award: The Golden Spark Plug Award is presented annually by Shawnee District, Shenandoah Area Council, BSA to recognize outstanding leadership, service, or spirit by an adult in support of the district as it provided quality Scouting programs to Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturers, and Explorers.

Awardees are selected by the district's adult leaders, and the awards are given based on three awards per year. The awards may only be given at the District's annual recognition dinner.

The Golden Spark Plug is co-equal with the Silver Spark Award and ranks below the District Award of Merit.



Silver Spark Plug Award: The Silver Spark Plug Award is presented annually by units in the Shawnee District, Shenandoah Area Council, BSA to recognize outstanding leadership, service, or spirit by an adult in support of a Cub Pack, Scout Troop, Venture Crew, or Explorer Post.

Awardees are selected by their unit's adult leaders, and the awards may only be given at the District's annual recognition event. One award per unit.

The Silver Spark Plug Award is co-equal with the Golden Spark Plug Award and ranks below the District Award of Merit.

The "Unsung Hero" Award: The "Unsung Hero" award is to recognize any adult who has made a special contribution to the success of their unit. The "Hero" is a volunteer who does not often get the "Thank You", but simply works to make the unit better or work more smoothly.
